WHAT IS IT?

A cabaret show and dark comedy with a theatrical through-line. Audiences are encouraged to dress in turn of the century inspired attire and the pre-show correspondence sets up the immersive premise. They have been invited to the grand unveiling of a famous magicians brand new act but the past comes back to haunt him as his act goes horribly wrong.

The show combines circus aerial performances, mind blowing mentalism, magic, comedy, tap dancing burlesque, live music, puppetry and ghosts! With pre-show installations, walkabout acts and DJ after, this package offers audiences a fantastic evening of unique and thrilling entertainment.

Commissioned for Norfolk & Norwich Festival 2017, this show has been made for a Speigeltent (Salon Perdu) but would also suit old Music Hall Theatres and Victorian venues.

BASIC TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2 x venue technical staff for operation of sound/lights.
- Minimum venue height of 5-6 metres.
- Overhead rigging point for aerial (hoop & chains).
- 2x radio lapel or head mics.
- Sound system - PA for band, mics, stand, foldback.
- A non-raked stage performance area and back stage area with space for large props, on the same level.
- Tab and tab track.
- Space for pre-show installations.

- 1 day (day of show)

RUN

- 2 nights minimum (Ideally 5 nights plus.)
